Gaylord Golf Club Player Protocols

Effective May 22, 2020

Note: these protocols are intended to protect players and staff of the Gaylord Golf Club. Please remain at least 6 feet from others while at the course.

Making tee times

- All tee time reservations to be made by phone or internet.
- All public play fees must be paid by credit/debit card. Credit information will be taken over the phone or internet to eliminate handling cards. Charges will not be processed until player arrives.
- All member charges will be to member accounts.

Arrival at the course

- Course staff will direct players to a clean sterilized cart.
- Players should load their own clubs to avoid touching equipment by staff.
- Carts will have score cards and pencils.
- Players from the same immediate family/living together may share a cart. All others ride separately.
- Member locker facilities are open. Bag storage is suspended until further notice.

Clubhouse

- The pro shop is open.
- Restrooms will be open. Limit 2 people at any one time.
- The Clubhouse and Dining room are open.
- The bar and grille will be open for normal service but with seating at 50% capacity and social distancing. Normal food and bar service is available.
- The deck is open for seating with social distancing.

Practice area

- The driving range is open.
- The practice area including the putting green are open.

Playing the Course

- The course and all tees are open for play.
- Do not remove or touch the flags. Take gimmie's when close and there is a device to prevent the ball from dropping to the bottom of the cup to make retrieval easier.
- All rakes, ball washers and sand buckets on tees have been removed.
- If you ball lands in a footprint or other depression in the bunker, place the ball on a smooth area nearby.
 Please attempt to smooth out the bunker.
- o Restrooms are open and sanitized daily.
- Remain at least 6 feet from you playing partners while on the course.
- Return power carts to the designated area in the parking lot. Please remove all trash when finished to avoid contact with others.
